CHALLENGE:

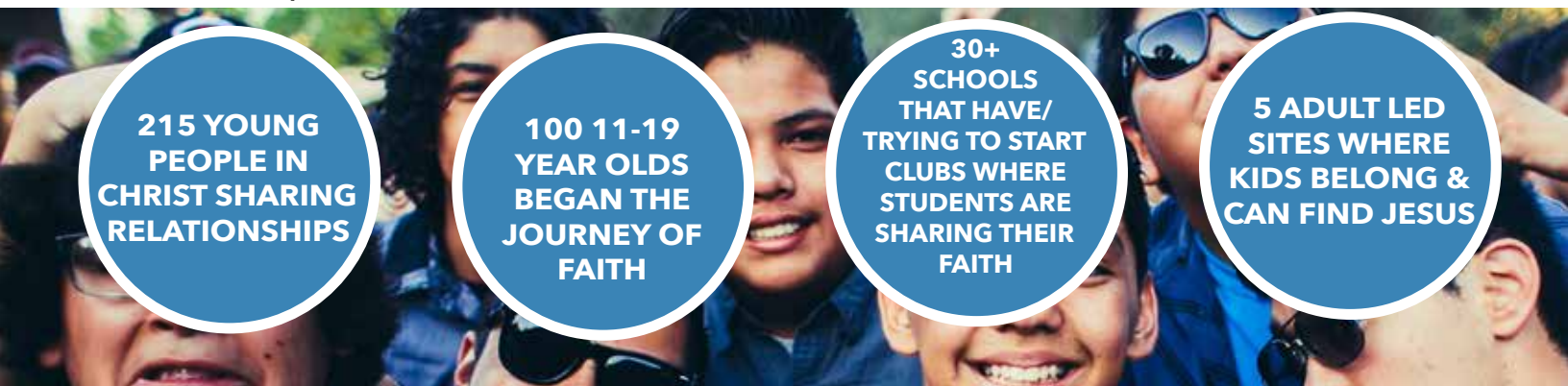

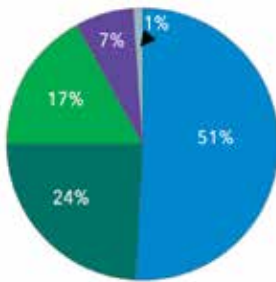
FINANCIALS

% of total income

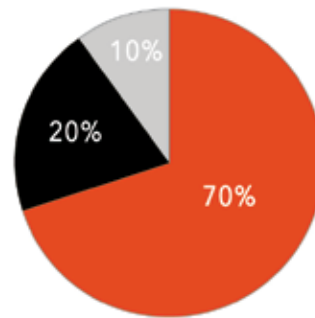
- 51% Individual Support
